Study on vulnerable landowners in four mouza in Jamalpur district

Uttaran in partnership with Manusher Jonno Foundation and CARE has been implementing SALE (Sustainable Access to Land Equality) project funded by European union in three upazilas of Bangladesh. The development goal of this project is to strengthen access to land and property rights for all citizens, especially the poorest segments. Mainly, the project intends to promotion of effective, transparent and accountable land governance practices towards access to equitable land and property rights for the poorest community.

Digital land survey has been conducted at four Mouza in Jamalpur intervention area as piloting of pilot upazilas. SALE project has conducted a survey to identify the target group. The identification of target landowners were based on land size under 10 decimals, women headed landowner, widow landowner, elderly landowner, minority landowner and indigenous land owner.

The data were collected by the Field Facilitators through house to house survey. The target group survey has been conducted from January 30 to February 06, 2014 at four mauza namely Kanil, Tajpur, Belbelia and Dapunia. The total 737 target people were found among the 1537 household including 57 women headed household where the average family size is 3.84. The primary findings of the study are given below:

Study on Land related documents: A survey has been conducted at four Mouza namely Tajpur, Belbelia, Dapunia and Kanil in Jamalpur sadar upazila. The survey was conducted from 12th March to 28th March, 2014. The main objective of the study is

- > To know the existing situation of their land related documents.
- > To identify people who have not proper land related documents

It has been easy to aware and supports the beneficiaries on digital land survey and record preparation. The snapshot of the study is only 4 percent respondent found those have record khatian of their land, 21 percent of target group have completed Dakhila and 39 percent of target group they have not completed the mutation of their land.
